

Piraeus approves participation and funding

Scope of the decision

The committee considered three connected matters: participation by Piraeus in PULSE-TWIN, acceptance of European funding and designation of the municipal directorates responsible for implementation.

Three concrete decisions

1. Participation by the Municipality of Piraeus in PULSE-TWIN under the European Urban Initiative was approved.
2. Funding was accepted. The supplied translation states a flat-rate amount of EUR 150,000 for this transfer partner: EUR 120,000 from the European Regional Development Fund and EUR 30,000 as the partner's own contribution.
3. The municipal directorates for Information Technology and New Technologies, and for European Programmes, Extroversion and Tourism, were designated for implementation.

What this source establishes

The decision supports the existence of the international partnership, a defined partner budget and administrative involvement by municipal technology and European-programme departments.

What this source does not establish

The decision does not show that facial recognition, individual AI profiles or every described technical component is already operational. It also does not provide a complete technical architecture or data-governance assessment.
